We would like to invite you to join in the festivities that attract consumers from the entire Tri-County Area, including the metropolitan areas of Allentown, Kutztown, and Reading, PA. In past years the event had a total of 14 breweries and 10 wineries represented with over 50 different brews and 40 wines. For those of you who have participated in prior years, your generosity and commitment to this event have enabled us to raise over \$100,000 to help improve the lives of children and families.

This year we are taking steps to provide you a better opportunity to have up to 500 individuals sample your merchandise. Knowing that the festival is an excellent, but none the less expensive venture, we are making changes to help share the cost with you yet provide benefits for participating:

- Your name will be included in Web advertising for the event and all participating wineries and breweries will have the opportunity to sell their own products according to Pa Laws.
- This year we will be having two 3-hour sessions.
- All participating wineries and breweries will get two complementary food tickets.
- Participants will be provided with an 8' exhibit table, 2 chairs, and ice & ice bins. (Taps are NOT provided).
- We will reimburse \$150.00 to Breweries. You can bring more product but due to the fact that this is a fund raiser and all profits are donated we need to keep our cost to a minimum.

RULES/INFORMATION:

- You may have 1 table and 2 chairs. A minimum of four cases or equivalent of each product you will be presenting is required. You must save 50% of your product for the second session. • **There is no fee for participation.**
- We request that each brewery honor its commitment and not run out of supplies so as not to cause embarrassment by leaving an empty table.
- Two FREE vendor passes will be given out. The names of the people working your table must be provided to us by **February 19, 2022**.
- All ticket purchasers who attend will be provided a 6 oz. logoed tasting glass – please do not fill above the 1 oz. line.
- No one under 21 will be allowed to enter the festival.
- No mugs or glass items are allowed to be sold during the festival, because they are then used for tasting, but you may sell or give away any other promotional items.
- Set up must commence no later than 1:30 PM.
- No samples may be poured within the last 15 minutes of each session to give people time to finish drinking. People are NOT permitted to leave with open containers of alcohol.
- Breweries must make arrangements for your products to be delivered by your distributor Friday, **February 18, 2022** or Saturday **February 19, 2022** 1:30 PM and BY APPOINTMENT ONLY. Wineries can bring their products when they set up the day of the festival.
- Wineries are permitted to sell their products in accordance to PA Law.
- Federal Tax ID # is 81-3655554 which can be used to write off your donations to this event. • Optimist Club of Kutztown, P.O. Box 137, Kutztown, PA 19530 has a special event Liquor License # 108245, which permits us to purchase and serve alcohol during this event.

DIRECTIONS TO EVENT:

From Allentown: Follow RT 78 west to RT 100 South. Follow Rt. 100 south about .25 mile, across a set of railroad tracks, to Schantz Road. Turn right onto Schantz road and follow Schantz road until it merges with RT 222, about 2 miles. Follow RT 222 South until it turns into a four-lane highway about 5 miles. Get off RT 222 at Exit 2, RT 737. Turn left onto RT 737 south and follow it to a stoplight. At the stoplight turn right and proceed to the third stoplight. Turn right. The Fairgrounds is two blocks on your right.

From Philadelphia: Follow the Northeast Extension of the Pennsylvania Turnpike to the Lehigh Valley Exit, number 32. Get off the turnpike and follow the directions from Allentown beginning with RT 78 west.

From Reading: Follow RT 222 north to exit 1, Virginville, Kutztown. Follow business RT 222 North past the airport, thru Kutztown University to the first stoplight. Turn left. The Fairgrounds is two blocks on your right.
